

Remote Counsellor



About the role:

You will be providing remote counselling through delivering HUK's therapeutic counselling program for people impacted by hoarding behaviour. Our participants may be experiencing a range of issues e.g., trauma, anxiety, loss, depression, financial, legal, and discriminatory abuse/neglect. You will be working with trained colleagues to alleviate housing, benefits, mental health, and other problems experienced by HUK's participants.

The role consists of:

- Volunteering at HUK a minimum of two hours each week in accordance with programme completion (normally one year).
- Maintain a caseload and all relevant paperwork.
- Attending monthly 1:2:1 supervision with optional group supervision.
- Complying with HUK's case-management procedures, training program and other relevant policies and procedures.

We are looking for:

- Accredited or working towards accreditation with the BACP or UKCP
- Qualified Counsellors/ Therapists with a minimum individual membership with the BACP or UKCP
- Student Counsellors/ Therapists with a minimum 50 client hours and student membership with the BACP or UKCP.
- Experience of delivering counselling remotely via zoom, Skype or telephone.
- Experience of working with vulnerable adults in a therapeutic role.
- Experience of providing support in mental health; experience of providing support in other areas would be advantageous such as housing, social care, legal.
- The ability to work sensitively and professionally with people facing difficult circumstances.
- A commitment to volunteering with HUK for the full programme delivery length.
- A commitment to values and ethos of HUK.

Training on hoarding behaviour and other relevant areas will be provided.
