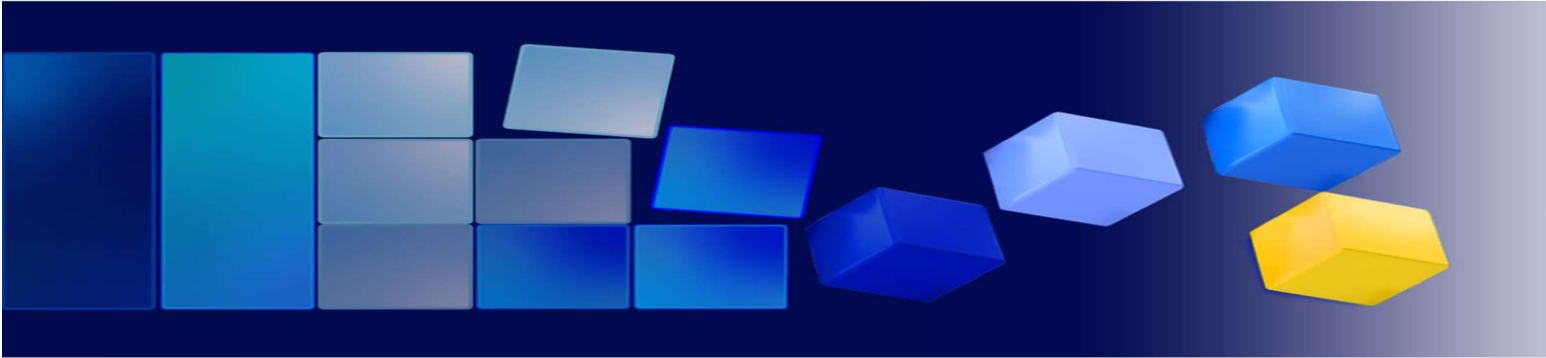


Social Media Volunteers
