About the role

You will be providing clinical supervision to trainee and volunteer counsellors who support those impacted by hoarding behaviour.

The role consists of:-

- Volunteering a minimum of four hours each week
- Providing accurate and timely clinical supervision to trainee and volunteer counsellors
- Maintaining a caseload of up to three
- Complying with HUK's case-management procedures, training program and other relevant policies and procedures.

- Qualified counsellors/psychotherapists currently enrolled in a clinical supervision training course
- Accredited or working towards accreditation with BACP, BABCP or UKCP
- Experience of working both face to face and remotely
- Good communication skills and ability to interact sensitively and professionally online
